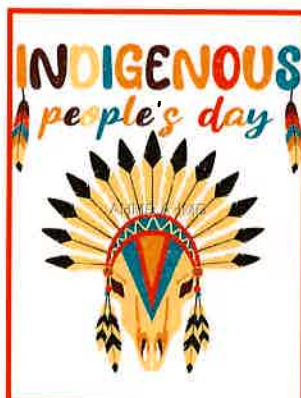

And then we went on to make beautiful mandala wind chimes!



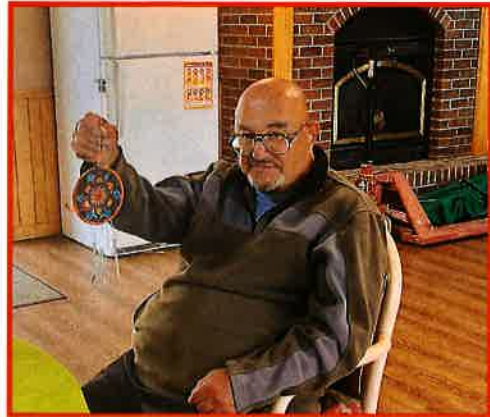
Q: Why did the newsletter become a detective?
